


TO ADJUST THE TORSO LENGTH, FOLLOW THESE STEPS:




 $2.1\,\mbox{Loosen}$ the pack's load lifters and harness straps. Open the zipper down.



2.2 Uncover the fastener and slide the shoulder harness up or down to the correct torso length.



2.3 After the position is adjusted, press the fastener in place to ensure that the fastener is firmly locked on the ribbon.



 $2.4\ \mbox{Close}$ the zipper , Your child carrier is now fitted to the adult.



2.5 Put on the backpack and place the hip strap in the center of the hip bone. Fasten your belt and fasten it. Make sure the hip belt is fully wrapped around your hip to ensure that the carrier's main weight is supported by your buttocks.



2.6 After fitting the hipbelt, tighten the shoulder harness by pulling the straps down and back.





2.8 Buckle and tighten the sternum strap. You are now ready to use your Child Carrier.


3.FIT AND SECURE THE CHILD

 $3.1\,\mbox{Open}$ the child's strap by loosening the fastener in front of the child's seat cushion.


- (1) Insert the inserting plate into the wing pocket slot;
- (2) Insert the buckle;
- (3) Tighten the buckle;



3.2 Open the guardrail on one side of the children's seat compartment to help children enter from the side, or from the top of the seat compartment.



3.3 For proper fit, the child's chin should be level to the top of the drool pad at the front of thecockpit. Place the child in the carrier to check if adjustment is needed.



3.4 Adjust the seat to ensure that the child's legs can be placed comfortably.
